At St Paul's, we are blessed with many opportunities to work generously in, with and for, the community of Egham Hythe

God has blessed us so richly, and as a Church we want to respond with grateful hearts and generous action.

Here are just some of the ways that giving to St Paul's blesses this community:

- **Youth Space** – Our Year 7 drop-in space has an average weekly attendance of 30 young people
- **Stepping Stones** – Our buzzing baby and toddler group connects local parents and carers of pre-school children
- **St Paul's Food Kitchen** – Delivers around 110 hot meals to people in the community each week
- **Messy Church** – Reaches between 20-30 local families and enables them to explore faith together
- **Godly Play** – Allows children aged 4-14 to grow in faith through story and play
- **Tea and Chat** – Invites older people in the community a space to enjoy the company of others
- **Food Bank** – From November we will host Runneymede Foodbank each Tuesday evening
- **Easter Activities** – Welcomes into the church building all KS1 and KS2 pupils from Hythe and Thorpe Lea primary schools
- **Christmas Tree Festival** – Attracts 550 visitors and hosts over 30 trees from local businesses, charities and community groups
- **Open Space Project** – With the support of Surrey County Council are currently seeking funding which will allow us to improve the building to better serve the community

All of which are completely free at point of use to ensure they are accessible to all

All this and more happens because WE ARE HERE.

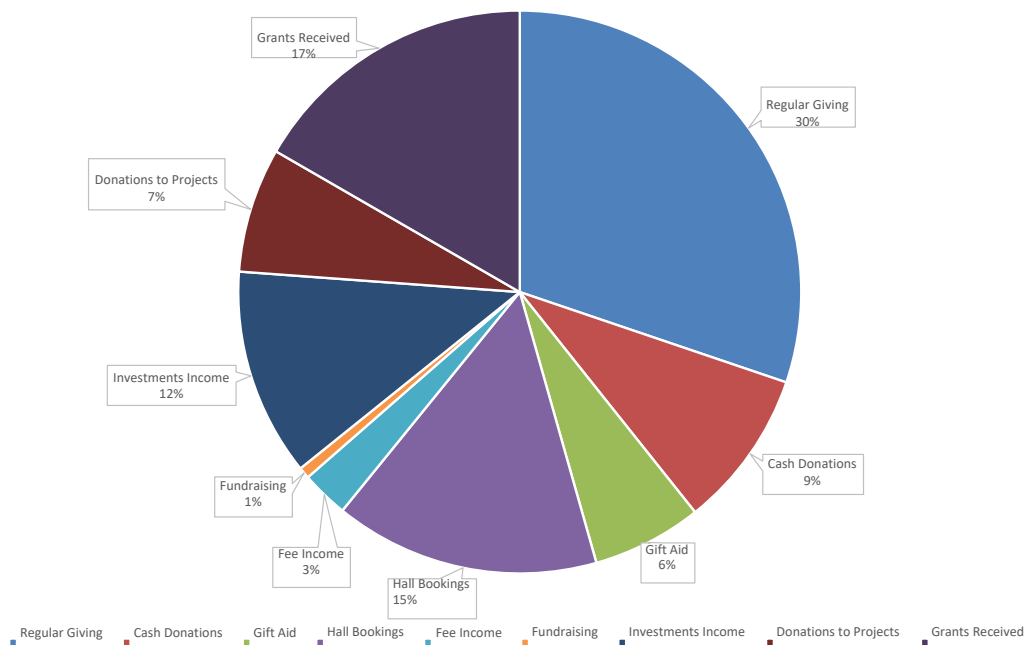
And we want to stay here.
