There is no charge for non-profit organisations. For businesses and commercial organisations we are asking for a £50 donation which goes to support this community initiative.

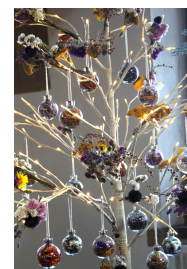
This year we also offer the opportunity to local businesses to sponsor not just one of the main events but also the Tree Festival itself.
